

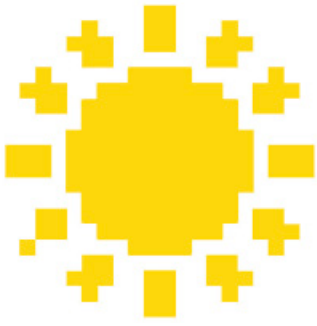

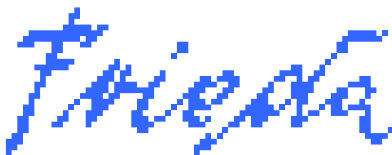
Please pre-register your child(ren) \$25 per class or bring a friend for a reduced rate of \$20 per class!

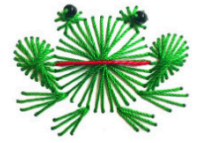

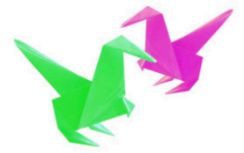

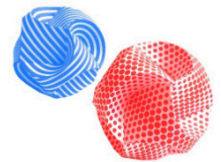
